## 2021 Overnight Options for Participants

As in the past, the Lenoir Aquatic & Fitness Center, located at 1031 Jim Barger Drive NE in Lenoir, is providing participating sculptors with free camping on Friday night only. On-site access to restrooms and showers will be available.

This year, we are offering a second free camping option at the WNC Sculpture Center & Park for Friday and Saturday nights. Located at 4612 Patterson School Drive in Lenoir, the facility is located just off of Highway 321 N., less than 11 miles north of the Broyhill Walking Park. This also is the site of the Friday Night Sculptor's Dinner (see below) and also offers restrooms and showers.

WNCSC&P can only accommodate a maximum of 15 tents, so sculptors are limited to one space. Because sites are first come-first served, early registration is highly encouraged. You will find signup space in the payment portion of your 2021 prospectus. When your completed form is received, Caldwell Arts Council staff will contact you with space confirmation.
