Meet our 2023 Juror, Kyle Van Lusk

Kyle Van Lusk studied at East Carolina University, earning his BFA in 1995 and his MFA in 1997. His large-scale steel works have been exhibited throughout the Southeast. Embodying an industrial elegance, Lusk's sculptures are heavily influenced by creative processes, the natural landscape, tool-like forms, and often the installation site itself.

Lusk currently resides in Brevard, NC with his family, where he serves as Professor of Art and Art Program Coordinator at Brevard College.
